Official terminology for conduct of Recognized Poomsae Competition  
For Methods of competition: Cut off System  
Preliminary & Semi-Final and Final round

## 1<sup>st</sup> Poomsae competition:

- 1) **LEFT hand**→ Chul-jeon (enter the court)
- 2) **LEFT hand**→ Chario
- 3) **LEFT hand**→ Kyong-re
- 4) **RIGHT hand**→ Chun-bi (start time)
- 5) **RIGHT hand**→ Si-jak
- 6) Baro (beginning break-off time of 1 minute)
- 7) Shiyo (take a rest)
- 8) **LEFT hand**→ Toe-jang (you can go to your coach)
- 9) **RIGHT hand**→ Peol-cheyo (publication of score on the screen)

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Poomsae competition:

- 10) Between 30 and 60 seconds call:
- 11) **LEFT hand**→ Chul-jeon (enter the court)
- 12) **LEFT hand**→ Chario
- 13) **RIGHT hand**→ Chun-bi (start time)
- 14) **RIGHT hand**→ Si-jak
- 15) Baro
- 16) **LEFT hand**→ Chario
- 17) **LEFT hand**→ Kyong-re
- 18) Shiyo (take a rest)
- 19) **RIGHT hand**→ Peol-cheyo (publication of score on the screen)
- 20) **LEFT hand**→ Toe-jang (exit the court)
